Generates awareness on entitlements and enhances participatory planning.



Enhances the role of SHG network in local governance process and promotes active citizenship.

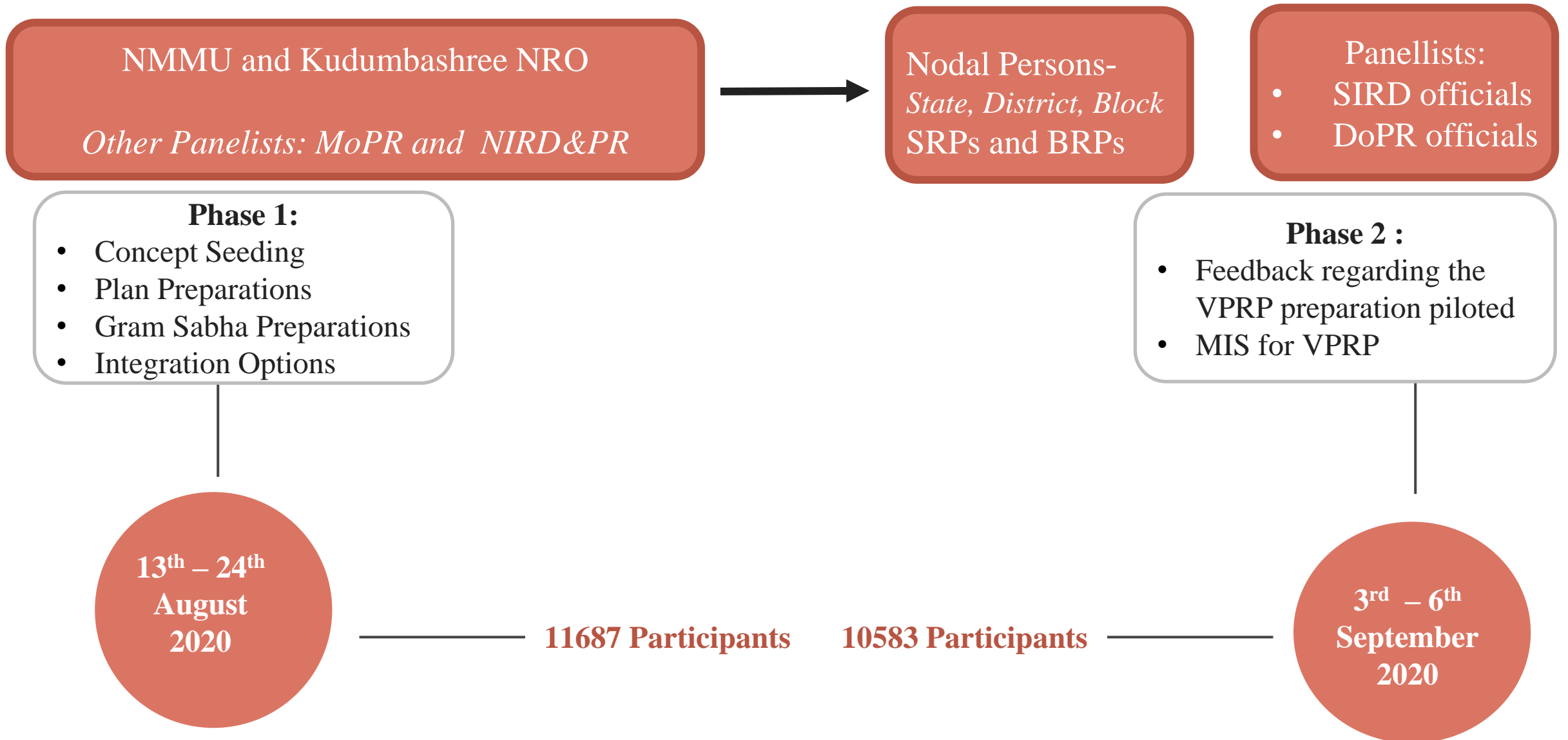

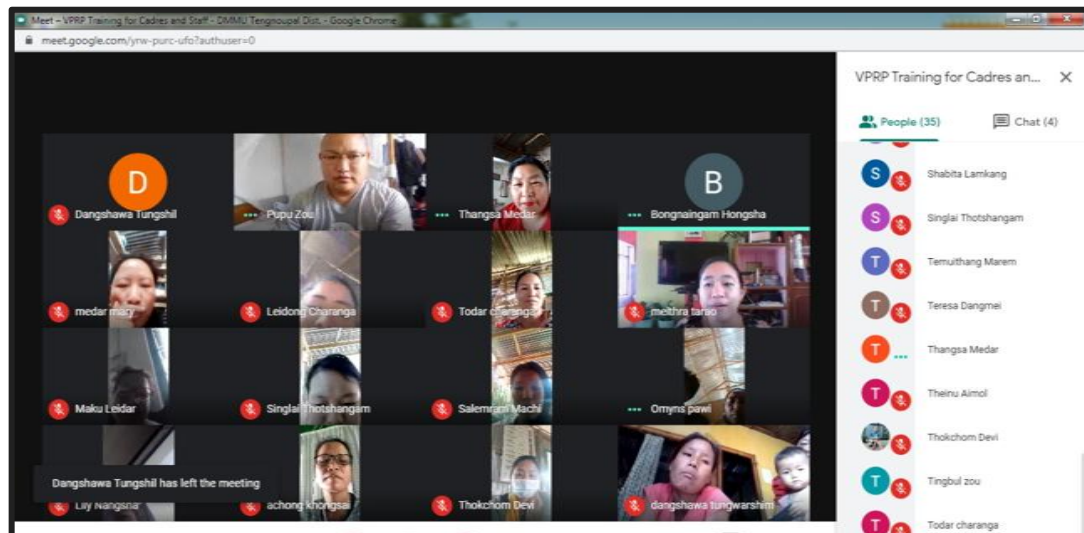

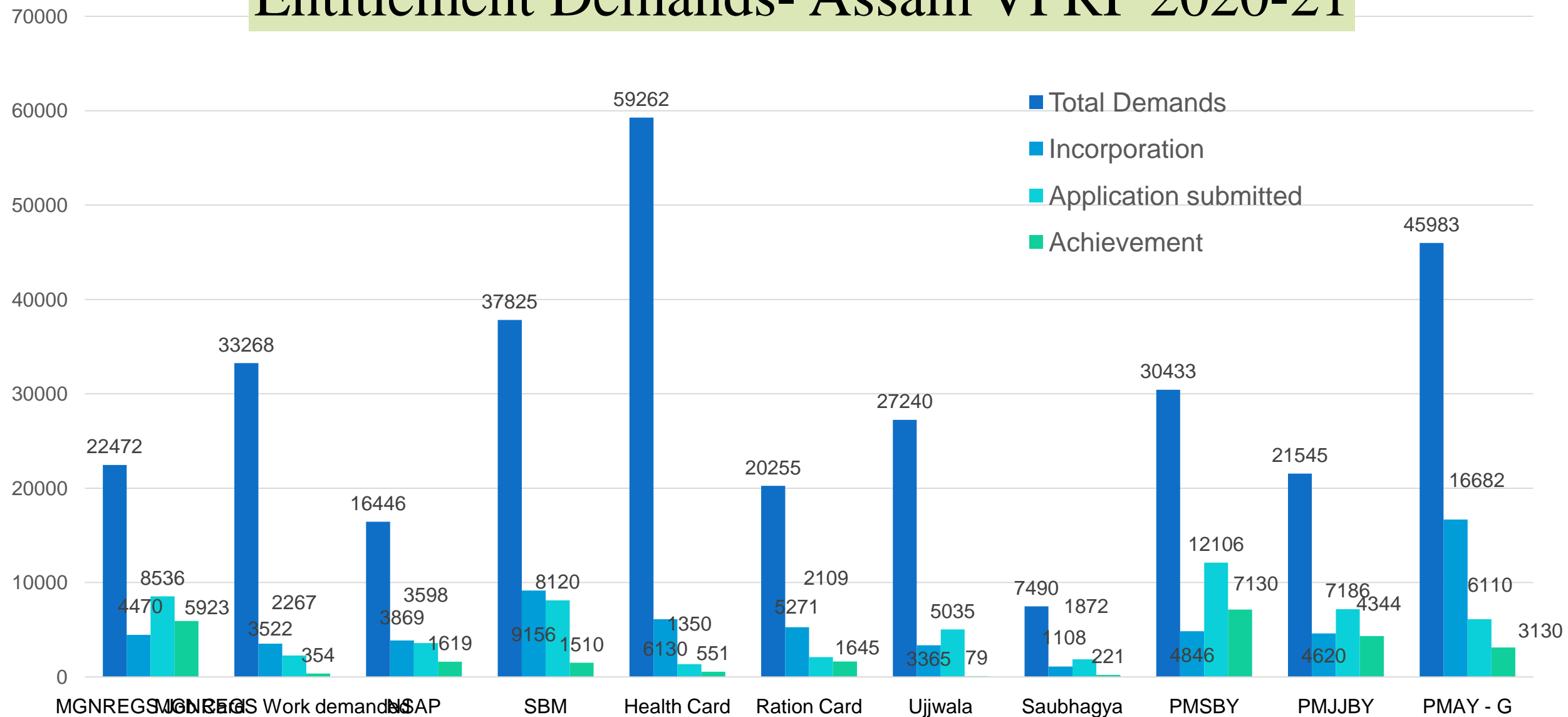

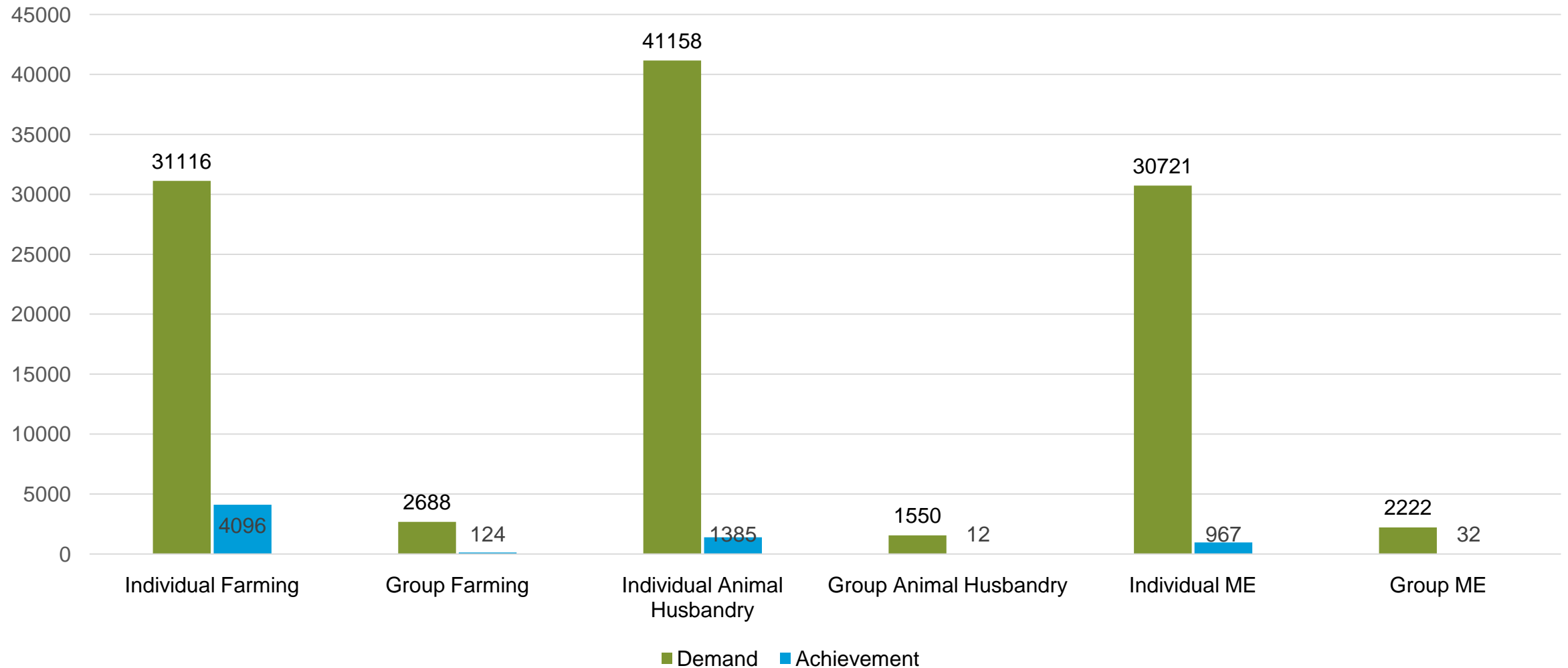

Entitlement Demands- Assam VPRP 2020-21



- **26% Beneficiaries have received MGNREGS Job Card through placing demands in VPRP**
- **23% Beneficiaries have enrolled under PMSBY schemes and 20% under PMJJBY schemes**

Livelihood Demands- Assam VPRP 2020-21



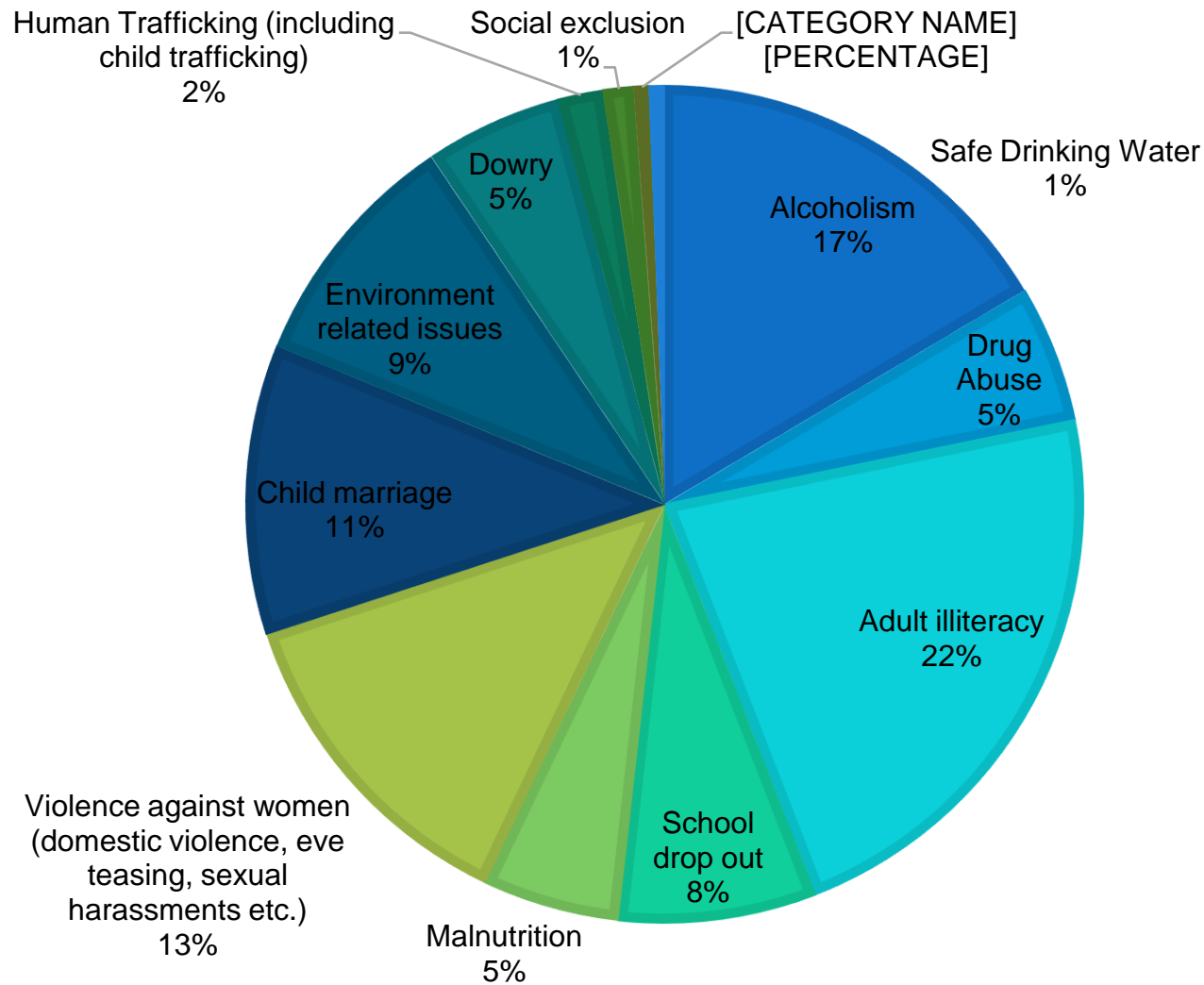
- **4096 Beneficiaries** have started farming individually after receiving supports such as seeds, spray machine, training and fertilisers from Agriculture Department
- **967 Beneficiaries** have started Micro Enterprise units after receiving supports such as training, yarn passbook and raw materials

- **Demands 806 VOs**
- **Demands from 17 subjects under XIth Schedule**
- **Highest Demand – Health and Sanitation**
- **Highest Incorporation – Land Improvement and Soil Conservation 44%**
- **Service demands such as teachers in schools, staff nurses, Mosquito nets, Equipment in sub- centres have also been placed**
- **32% Demand for Roads and Culverts**

Social Development Plan Demands- Demands- Assam VPRP 2020-21



- 38 GPs have placed Adult illiteracy as their Social Development Plan
- 22 GPs consider Violence against women as the biggest social evil
- Alcoholism being a rampant issue has been taken up by 28 GPs

Challenges

- Lack of awareness of PRI representatives across states on VPRP
- Difficulty in organising special Gram Sabha for VPRP
- Very Less participation and involvement of line departments
- Lack of appropriate mechanism for monitoring & tracking integration the VPRP plans into GPDP
- Technical issues in uploading VPRP into www.gpdp.nic.in
- Lack of clarity on status of sanction/ implementation of GPDP 2020-21 - demotivation for next planning process

VPRP preparation strategy 2021-22: Introduction of Mobile based application

VPRP APP DETAILS :

- Offline data collection option
- Developing in different regional languages
- Options to include state specific schemes and services
- Automatic consolidation of data and report generation
- Automatic backend linkage of demands to departments

SCOPE OF THE APP:

- Tracking of the incorporation status by line departments
- Funds allocated for each project can be monitored
- Tracking of demand incorporation and implementation of sanctioned works by VOs and SRLMs

Support from States

- ❖ State level GPDP guidelines to include-Recognition of VPRP and Integration of demands in to GPDP
- ❖ Clarity on preparation of GPDP and uploading in *gdpd.nic.in* and *e-gram swaraj* portals with specific to Schedule VI areas and other VCs in NER.
- ❖ Inclusion of VPRP as a special agenda in GPDP Gram Sabhas
- ❖ Formation of a state level coordination committee with DoPR and SRLM
- ❖ Ensure the participation and involvement of line departments in GPDP Gram sabhas and including department specific demands into their Annual Action Plans
- ❖ Training PRIs and DoPR officials on VPRP integration
