1.1 Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme



OBJECTIVE

Credit linked subsidy scheme to set up new units to create employment in both urban & rural areas in India



SUPPORT GIVEN

Subsidy for project costs up to:

- Manufacturing sector : Rs. 25 Lakhs
- Service sector: Rs. 10 Lakhs

Subsidy:

- General category: 15% in urban and 25% in rural areas
- Special Category: (SC/ST/OBC/Minorities/Women/ PH/ NER & Hill areas) - 25% in urban and 35% in rural areas
- Individual contribution: 5% (Special Category), 10% (General)
- Second finance (loan) up to INR 1.0 cr. with 15% subsidy (20% for NER/ Hill areas)

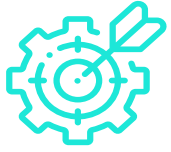

 - Rs. 5 cr. as financial assistance for more than 500 artisans
- Assistance provided for—
 - Procurement of machinery
 - Raw material bank
 - Construction of Common Facility Centre
 - Training & Skill development
 - Design & product development
 - Market linkages

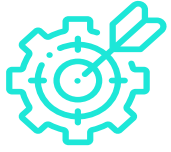

OBJECTIVE





To support rural micro sector with skill development, entrepreneurship, and boost innovation



SUPPORT GIVEN

- Govt gives up to Rs. 100 lakh for Government Institutes and up to Rs. 50 lakh for Private institutes for procurement of plant and machinery for setting up a Livelihood Business Incubator (LBI)

3.3 Convergence Opportunities for PRIs and ASPIRE

- 01 Identifying the requirement of sector specific technical training
- 02 Identifying Block/ District level technical institutes which can be set up as LBIs to provide training for job in local industries
- 03 Identifying students for training in existing LBIs/LBIS to be set up
- 04 Supporting trained students/incubates by connecting them to various Govt. schemes

4.1 National SC-ST Hub



OBJECTIVE

To provide professional support to SC & ST Entrepreneurs to achieve the mandate of a minimum of 4% of total procurement from SC/ST owned MSEs



SUPPORT GIVEN

- Provision of 25 % capital subsidy for procurement of Plant & Machinery through credit to the SC-ST MSEs of manufacturing sector (max subsidy - Rs.25 Lacs)
- Reimbursement of Membership fee of Export Promotion Councils (50% or Rs.1 Lac whichever is lower).
- Reimbursement of Bank loan processing fee (50% or Rs.1 Lac whichever is lower).
- Reimbursement of Bank charges on Performance Bank Guarantee (50% or Rs.1 Lac whichever is lower).
- Reimbursement of fees of short-term courses of the top 50 NIRF rated management institutions (90% or Rs.1 Lac whichever is lower)

- 04 Provide trainings to the SC-ST beneficiaries at the government funded training centers available under PRIs at Taluk, block and district levels
- 05 Identification of successful SC ST entrepreneurs at the Taluk, Block and District level to be showcased as a case study
