#### Minutes of the Meeting

During the financial Year 2018–19 the progress of uploading approved Gram Panchayat Development Plans (GPDP) on Plan Plus application is 99.06 percent. Remaining GPDP will be uploaded as soon as possible to achieve cent percent achievement. Along with it the 17 goals of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals were discussed for its incorporation in preparation of GPDP for the financial Year 2019-20.
- People's Plan Campaign will be organized from 2<sup>nd</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018 all across the country. For this campaign nodal officer are nominated at the state level and directions were circulated for nominating nodal for District, Panchayat Samiti and Gram Panchayat. Pre Planning Preparation arrangements directions for preparation of GPDP 2019- 20 were given to all District Collectors of the State. Directions were issued to all action of facilitates. Chief Executive Officers (CEOs) for selection of facilitators at each Gram Panchayat.
