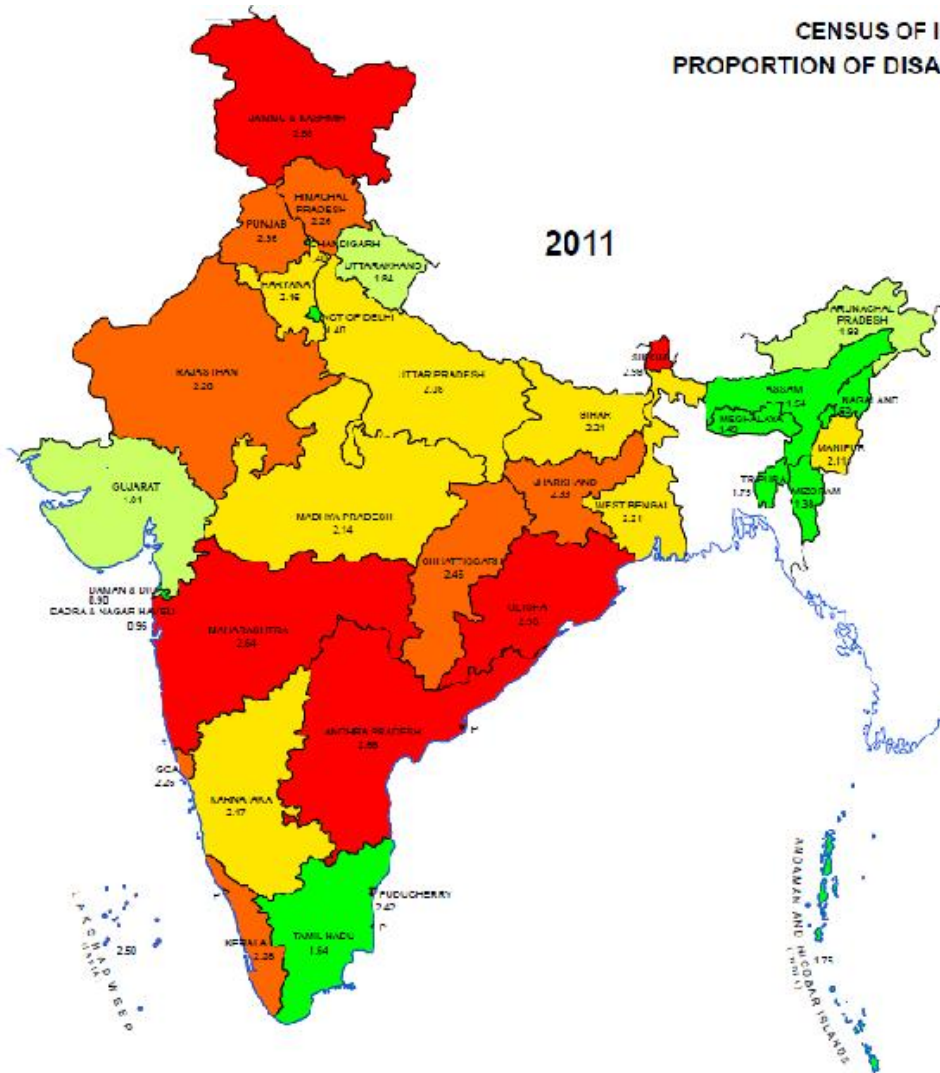

ü **Red colour** indicates more than 2.26% above proportion of disabled population.
(Total 2.21% out of 121 crores)

ü At all India level 7.62% belonged to 0-6 years children.

ü Majority 69% resides in rural areas
1.86 crores0.81 crore in urban

ü 17.1 million are non workers.

ü Out of total disabled population **50%** from five states
....**UP, MH, Bihar, AP, WB.**

Why inclusion of people with Disability?



- ü **Poverty creates disability and disability creates poverty.**
- ü **People with disability are often among the poorest of the poor.**
- ü **The population of Disability are 15-20% in developing countries.
(World Bank estimation)**
- ü **Due to number of social exclusions faced by persons with disabilities, the majority of families with persons with disabilities are living in poverty.**

- ü Local authorities as “problem solvers” at the village level, to ensure that **village planning and budgets respond to the needs of PWDs.**
- ü Sensitisation activities for social acceptance among women groups.
- ü Economic Empowerment of Disabilities to be the part of GPDP
- ü Inclusion in income generating activities.
- ü Disabled specific Service delivery should be planned in GPDP
- ü Sustainability of Disability mainstreaming.
- ü **Note: Triangulation of the Data related to PWD is very important in planning.**
